Sunday, December 8: Commitment Sunday



A Message from Mother Liz

Dear St. Thomas family:

St. Thomas Church is a mustard seed faith church. Since our founding, generation after generation has offered their gifts to St. Thomas Church, making us who we are today.

God is not finished with St. Thomas Church! As we continue to treasure the seed of faith that God has planted in and among us, we can continue to be the mustard tree for the Eastside. We can continue to be a place where all people can experience God's love and peace, a place where all people



can be rooted in faith in God, be nourished by Christ, and branch out to the community with God's love for the world.

We need your help to continue living into God's vision for St. Thomas Church. We need your presence, your voice, and your gifts—your mustard seeds of faith. The *Forward in Faith* Campaign invites everyone to share their mustard seed faith by participating in what God is doing through St. Thomas.

Enclosed is a pledge card for the *Forward in Faith* campaign. The card invites you to make a pledge to our annual operating budget and the Rector Housing Fund (over 3 years), in addition to your annual giving of your time and talent.

On Sunday, December 8th at the 8 am and 10 am services, we will bring our pledge cards and offer them as gifts, our mustard seeds of faith. If you cannot attend or are not yet ready to commit on December 8, a member of our campaign team is happy to talk with you, answer any questions you may have, and to receive your pledge card.

Before you decide what to financially commit to our campaign, please:

- 1) Pray. Ask God for guidance in how much to commit to giving through reflection and prayer.
- 2) Consider what a mustard seed gift is for you. A mustard seed gift is a bold-faith gift. To give this gift, you may have to reorder your financial priorities. You might consider gifting an asset such as stock or property.
- 3) Seek to grow in faith through your giving. Seeing your gift as a mustard seed of faith will increase your faith and awareness of God as the Giver from whom all good things come!

To reach our goals, each of us is being asked to give a mustard seed gift. The future of our church and our mission depends on each of our responses. Together, with our mustard seed faith, we are becoming something far beyond what we could have asked or imagined!

Successful "Forward in Faith" Gatherings

Over the last few weeks, *Forward in Faith*Small Group Gatherings have been held in members' homes, at the church, and online.
These sessions were an opportunity to learn more about the needs of our church and the

invitation to respond through our stewardship campaign. Over 75 members of St. Thomas have attended. Below are a few questions that came up and insights from those participating:

Q: If a house is purchased for the rectory, where would it be?

A: Areas that have been discussed include the footprint of the Bellevue School District or the Kirkland area. These areas both offer a reasonable commute with more competitive home prices.

Q: What about our other clergy? They are currently living in the Seattle area as well.

A: The initial focus of this campaign is for housing support for the Rector, however the long term goal is to be able to support other clergy as needed and as funds allow.

Q: If it's going to take us 3 years to raise the money for our Rector Housing Fund, do we have to wait 3 years before we can help our current Rector?

A: The reality is that the 3 year fulfillment period gives us the best chance to raise the greatest amount of money, but that doesn't mean we have to wait 3 years to act. We do expect some donors to accelerate their contributions, and once we receive our first donations, we will be able to realistically assess how the fund might be put to work toward improving the current situation.
